The matters addressed by the committee this year have included:

 Review and feedback regarding revisions to Policy 6-316 proposed by the Office for Faculty (Fall 2023). Report submitted November 2023. Review and feedback regarding definitions proposed by SACAP and Senate officers, respectively, of academic freedom and tenure for potential posting to Senate website (April 2024). Report pending.

• Review of two academic freedom and faculty rights complaints (April 2024). Review currently underway.
