- Policies and rules considered in 2020–2021 academic year:
 - Rules and guidelines supporting Policy 4-004, considering network connections and security.
 - Proposed Rule 4-050B, University Software Acquisition Approval.
“University Software – is any software that is purchased, leased, or developed, or otherwise acquired by a University of Utah administrative or academic unit, for use by that University unit. ”
 - Proposed Policy 4-010 University Employee Individual Email Policy.
